SERVICES

ULTRASONOGRAPHY: For your convenience, we currently provide ultrasounds performed by Registered Diagnostic Medical Sonographers. Obstetric and gynecological ultrasounds can be completed at the time of your visit. Fetal biophysical profiles are also available at each office. As an additional elective service, we provide "early gender ultrasounds" at each office for the purpose of identifying your baby's gender. These can be done as early as fifteen weeks. 4-D ultrasounds are also available at our Wolfchase office as an elective service, and we can provide expecting moms with a high-definition recording of the baby's 4-D pictures.

PREGNANCY MONITORING: Non-stress testing for fetal evaluation is available at each of our locations. When concerns arise about the status of your baby, you can be monitored on-site during your visit.

HYSTEROSONOGRAPHY: As a relatively new in-office ultrasound procedure, hysterosonography utilizes the injection of a small amount of water through the cervix into the uterus for better visualization. This procedure aids in determining appropriate treatment methods for patients with abnormal bleeding and other uterine irregularities.

URINARY TESTING: For women experiencing bladder and urinary dysfunction, we offer diagnostic testing at our Baptist Women's and Wolfchase locations. This painless and non-invasive procedure allows the physician to evaluate your condition and determine appropriate treatment plans.

BONE DENSITOMETRY (DEXASCAN): Using a very small dose of radiation, a scan of certain bones is performed to determine density and measure bone loss. This enables the physician to identify your level of risk for a fracture and then decide upon the best course of action for your bone health. It is performed at our Baptist Women's. Wolfchase, and Germantown locations.

COLPOSCOPY/LEEP: In-office diagnosis of abnormal Pap smears can be aided by the use of colposcopic and LEEP equipment. These allow the physician to magnify suspicious areas and take necessary biopsies in the office.

REVERSIBLE BIRTH CONTROL: Our physicians perform several methods of reversible birth control, including the IUD's (intrauterine devices) Mirena, Skyla, and Paragard, the Implanon skin implant, injectible Depo-Provera, and pills, patches, and rings.

MAMMOGRAPHY: Convenient screening mammography is offered at our Baptist Women's, Wolfchase and DeSoto locations. Performed by registered mammography technicians, and using the latest digital mammography equipment, our studies are read by the radiologists servicing the Women's Health Center.

COSMETIC SERVICES: Our Germantown location offers the latest technology in laser, with the new GentleMax treatment system by Candela. This treatment is for hair removal, skin rejuvenation, and spider veins. The laser delivers a controlled amount of therapeutic heat, while a dynamic cooling device protects the upper layers of your skin. This procedure offers optimal treatment with minimal side effects. We also offer Botox, dermal fillers, Vivité® Vibrance, and Latisse for those wanting to look as young as they feel!

IN-OFFICE SURGICAL PROCEDURES: With new technology, we now perform many surgical procedures which historically had to be handled at an off-site facility. These procedures include hysteroscopy, endometrial ablation, and the Essure permanent birth control procedure. These procedures are usually performed in less than an hour.






